



NEIGHBORHOOD WATCHER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The ultimate success of the Norfolk Neighborhood Watch Security Program lies with the individual residents of that neighborhood. This citizen is called a Block Watcher.

The Neighborhood Watcher's responsibilities are:

- 1. To act as the eyes and ears of the neighborhood and report suspicious activity to the appropriate persons or authority.***
- 2. To study available crime prevention materials to implement appropriate improvements in their personal and residential security.***
- 3. To check their neighbor's home when asked or when they have knowledge that the neighbor is away.***
- 4. To secure their home in compliance with suggestions made in a home security survey.***
- 5. To participate in the Operation Identification Program (marking property and displaying decal).***
- 6. To inventory all personal property of value.***
- 7. To cooperate with and assist the Neighborhood Watch Coordinator and the Norfolk Police Department, Crime Prevention Section with programs to help reduce crime in their community.***
- 8. To attend scheduled meetings and training sessions.***
- 9. To stay in contact with neighbors and greet new residents.***
