The police noticed an uptick in petty crime when the courts came down and we have been pushing hard to find a replacement court for the youth. Bill Speidel of the city was kind enough to come with an update.

As you may know, two members, Robert and Louise Owens have stepped up to manage our Community Garden at the corner of 18th And Pleasant Ave. They asked to come and update you on their plans and needs.

- Had over 30 volunteers for their “Holiday in the Garden” event
- Over 300 guests visited during the event
- April 11th – “Reading in the Garden” event scheduled. Will be reading the children’s “Beatrix Potter” book series
- “Adopt a Native Plant” program introduced to help raise funds for the community garden
- Plantings begin on April 4th after the last anticipated possible hard freeze
- The EOVCCL Donated \$500 to the community garden
- Volunteers are need to tear down old beds and build new ones
- There is a need for an irrigation specialist to install new irrigation system before April 1st - person volunteered during the meeting
- March 7th- 8:30 AM - Event to get the beds ready- Looking for help from the Lake Taylor HS NJROTC program
- Will be starting a Kids Garden Club this spring

Community Updates:

Beach Trash Cans-at our meeting on 1/8, Richard Broad with the city requested I speak with membership about the trash cans on the beach. He’d like me to deputize all of you to place the cans in the appropriate places. They have someone emptying them weekly and placing at the walkovers and someone drags them away from the walkovers. Sending staff out to keep moving cans is very inefficient. He wrote an article for me to share that will be in the next newsletter.

Storm Sewer meeting- We had a meeting on 1/8 with 8 staffers from the City and concerned citizens on the Water Sewer replacement of 16, 17, 18 (next phase). The result of that meeting was that they would also be replacing the Stormwater system at the same time. Current stormwater system is very undersized. Box Culvert needed. 1 year out for project.
