I currently have 44 votes of support that were emailed. I have 2 votes opposed to the Conditional Use Permit. The CUP would allow her to operate a used clothing resale shop that is targeted to help low income people with interview/work clothes and prom and special event wear. Tommy Smigiel spoke regarding the City's opposition to resale shops, especially on Little Creek. Andria said that was planning Commissions position as well when she was on it. This is a resale shop and she was doing a great deal of mail order business and using this as her business address. There was a motion to TABLE her request for a letter of support and it was approved by membership.

Pathway Homes and their request for a zoning change on Ransom Road and Shore Drive Property.

We don't need a vote of support, but we had 40 votes of support for the zoning change. 5 people voted against more apts.

Stated that the COVID-19 pandemic and its' economic effects are seriously crippling the city budget, but that no decision has been made about any closures. Grave concern was raised by the OVCL because of the tremendous amount of value that the rec. center senior program adds to the community residents seniors.
